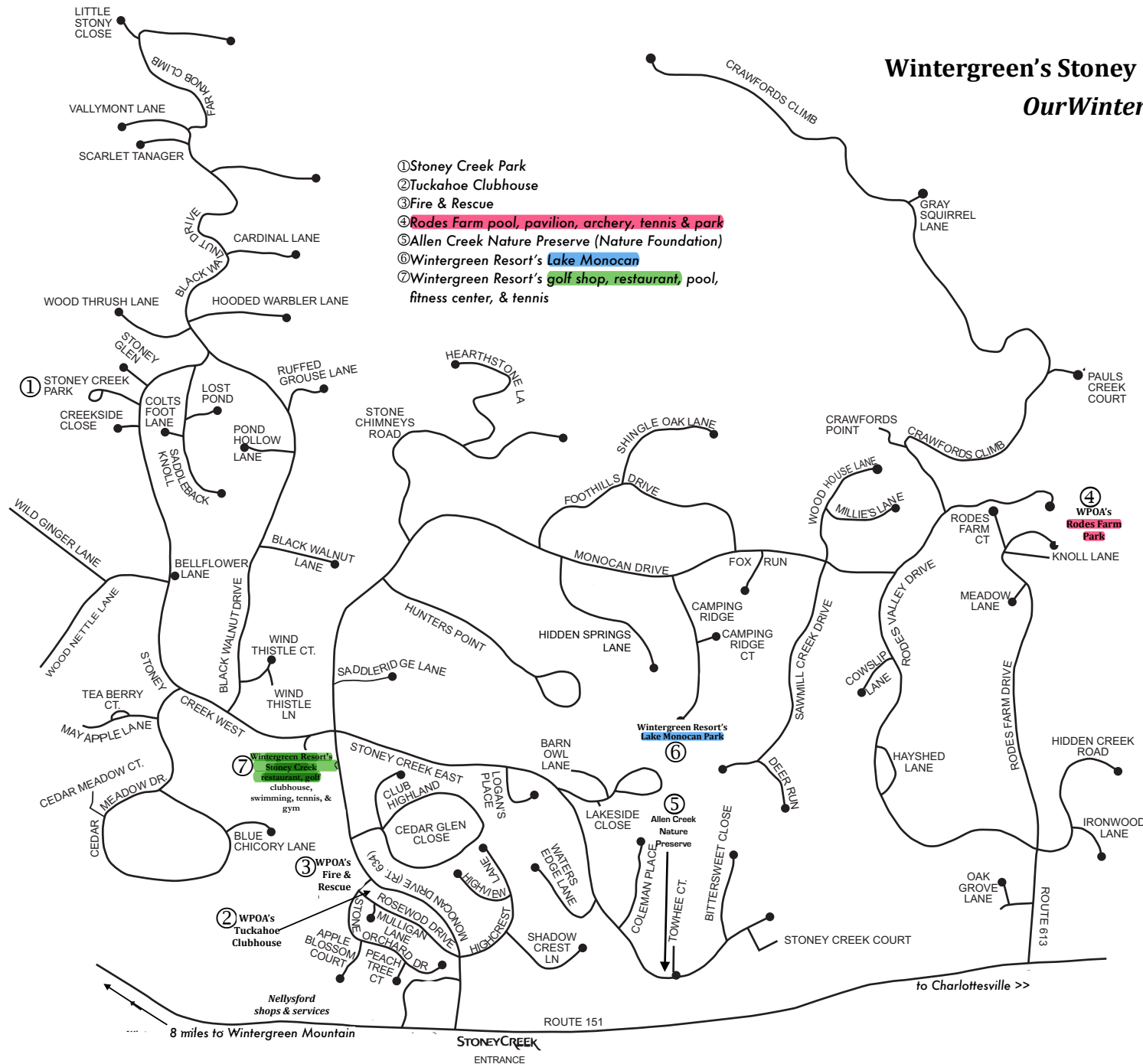

## Wintergreen's Stoney Creek Community

In Stoney Creek, Wintergreen Resort has:

- Stoney Creek Bar and Grill,
- a 27-hole public golf course with a pro shop and locker rooms,
- a swimming pool,
- a gym,
- four outdoor Har-Tru tennis courts,
- Lake Monocan, a 20-acre lake with a staffed swimming beach.

The resort offers different membership levels which offers members unique programs and special privileges at its facilities.

In Stoney Creek, the Wintergreen Property Owners Association has:

- Tuckahoe Clubhouse,
- Rodes Farm, a park that includes a swimming pool with pavilion, tennis court, playground, horseshoes, archery range, and picnic tables next to a pond,
- A park with a walking trail next to Stoney Creek,
- A network of walking and biking trails.

WPOA's amenities on the mountain and in Stoney Creek are available to all Wintergreen property owners.

A large farmers' market is held every Saturday morning at the entrance of Stoney Creek from May to November on WPOA property.

There are nine fishing ponds maintained by WPOA for property owners, including a stocked trout pond. A stocked trout stream runs through Stoney Creek and other WPOA property.

The Nature Foundation at Wintergreen owns and maintains Allen Creek Nature Preserve, and maintains three hiking trails in the valley on WPOA property.

There are about 2,900 homes, townhouses, and condominiums in all of Wintergreen. There are just under 600 homes and townhouses in Stoney Creek. On Wintergreen Mountain there are about 1,100 houses and almost 1,200 condos. There is just under 400 undeveloped lots on the mountain and about 300 lots in the valley. (2019)
