PARKING DIRECTIONS


Please park on the upper landing near the garage. You can take either path down to the side entrance of the house - please be careful and watch your step.

LOFT SPACE

CHECK IN: AFTER 4PM

You'll receive your unique entrance code on the morning of your arrival. Since it's self-check-in, you're welcome to arrive any time after 4pm at your convenience (whether it's 4pm on the dot, 11pm, or 2am the next morning). We don't require a specific time or walk through with us!

CHECK OUT: BEFORE 10AM

We try to make your getaway as stress-free as possible... so we don't have a huge departure checklist. We simply ask that you start the dishwasher with the dishes you've used and leave the house in good condition. You are welcome to leave linens as they lie and leave trash bags in their respective cans around the home.

We've gotten feedback that some people want a little more guidance (we're both first-born children - we get it). If you'd like, you are welcome to take the trash out to the cans outside the garage (though not necessary) or pile your towels in the bathtub (again, not required). We ask that you leave sheets on beds (you don't have to make them) so we can spot clean before washing.

*BEACHES


- Empire Beach (South Bar, has a playground, bonfire pits)

LEELANAU PENINSULA WINE TRAIL

Leelanau is one of the two wine trails in TC. Some of our favorite stops for Leelanau wine tasting are:

- Black Star Farms






FISHTOWN (AKA LELAND)

This is the most adorable little fishing village. There are lots of little shops to wander through in between a tasty lunch and ice cream.

Things TO DO WITH KIDS

MOOMERS

The World-Famous Moomers is a fun place to get ice cream and admire the cow farm right outside. It's always a big hit for kids of all ages. The line may be long during the summer, but it moves pretty quickly so don't let that deter you!

HISTORIC BARNS PARK

Historic Barns Park and the Botanic Gardens are places we could spend an abundance of time. In this little area, there are masterful flower, butterfly, and Asian-inspired "secret" gardens, historic barns from the Old State Hospital, fairy gardens created by locals, trails into the woods that overlook the entire city, and a kid's garden with a couple fun activities. It's a great place for picnicking and exploring - and the best part is that it's completely free!

JACOB'S FARM

Jacob's Farm is a stunner for the summer and fall. With several play structures, lots of outdoor/flex seating, cocktails, cider, food, live music in the summer, corn mazes in the fall, it's a wonderful place that is fun for kids (and adults) of all ages!

GLEN LAKE SCHOOL PLAYGROUND

Glen Lake Schools built a state-of-the-art accessible playground that is a blast for kids of all ages. During the summer months (when school is not in session), this is a great place to get some energy out. It's very large and has many different types of structures to keep kids interested for hours.







BEST RESTAURANTS

MODERN BIRD

If you're looking for an excellent fine dining restaurant, Modern Bird is a wonderful option (reservation suggested). Every item on their menu is absolutely incredible.



FOLGARELLIS

Locals are obsessed with Folgarelli's (to go only). They have the most incredible sandwiches which are wonderful for picnics or day trips.



GRAND TRAVERSE PIE COMPANY

If you're looking for a quick and affordable lunch that is unique to Traverse City, GT Pie Company is a must, with a menu similar to Panera Bread, but with a Traverse City twist. Don't skip out on their award winning pie!



BUBBA'S

If you're looking for a good burger downtown, Bubba's is the place to go. They boast fantastic burgers and equally good fries along with other menu items.



BEST WINERIES



CHATEAU CHANTAL

This winery has been in business for over 30 years and has some of the most incredible views in all of Traverse City, overlooking BOTH bays. Enjoy a glass of wine indoors or on one of their two patios .

SHADY LANE CELLARS

The setting for this winery is absolutely stunning. Located on Leelanau Peninsula, this winery offers a variety of wines in their incredible tasting room and also offer tours of their vineyard.

BONOBO

Located on Old Mission Peninsula, Bonobo allows you to buy wine by the glass at the bar and enjoy beautiful outdoor seating as well as indoor seating options.

SUTTONS BAY CIDERS

If cider is more your speed, Northern Michigan has several great options, including Suttons Bay Ciders. With incredible views and beautiful tasting room, this is a must for cider lovers.


