From the Portland Area:

Continue on I-95 North past Portland. 15 miles

Take Exit 63. (Gray, Bethel recreational area) Make a left off the exit ramp at the light, then immediately stay right. 0.5 miles

Make a right onto Rt 26 North. **26.4** miles

Note: Shortly after you pass Walmart on Rt. 26 you will be entering Norway. In Norway, there will be a Hannaford grocery store (next to Pizza Hut) on your right. This is a convenient stop to do your shopping. You are about 35 minutes from the house at this point.

When you get to the light in Norway (at the Rite Aid), make a right staying on Rt 26. At the end, make a left, staying on Rt 26 North. Take this into Bethel. 25 miles

When you get into Bethel (after the Welcome to Bethel sign), follow the signs for Rt 2 and Recreation Area, making a right onto Parkway Rd. This will take you past the lumber yard. If you go into town (Main Street), you missed the turn. At the stop sign (at Rite Aid), turn right onto Rt 2

0.5 mile

Stay on Rt 2 East until you get to the Sunday River Brewing Company on your left (can't miss it).

5 miles

Make a left onto Sunday River Road. At the Y, make a right, following the signs for the Grand Jordan Hotel, staying on Sunday River Rd. 3 miles

At the next Y, stay left onto Monkey Brooke Road, continuing to head toward the Jordan Grand.

2.2 miles

- At the Mahoosuc Glen entrance sign on the right, make a right onto Trillium Dr. If you get to the entrance of the Golf Course, you have gone too far.
- Take Trillium to the end, and make a left onto Goose Eye, then immediately make a right onto Wilderness Drive.
- Make the first right onto the cul-de-sac and turn left on the cul-de-sac road. Ours is the long driveway on the left of the cul-de-sac. The house sits back from the road and is difficult to see from the road. Ours IS NOT the house right in front of you on the cul-de-sac. Lamp posts line the driveway and there is a stone entrance pillar labeled Glen House. Please respect our neighbor's privacy and do not park in front of their homes or knock on their doors.
