House Access

Be mindful of ice, snow or rain, which could make walkways and steps slippery and injury could occur. A keypad code will be provided to you via text and/or e-mail prior to your visit. This key code is used to access the door key pads.

Trash gets picked up by the Town early Wednesday mornings, which may not align with your check-in date. If you are staying mid-week, please wheel the trash bins to the curb Tuesday evening.

AC in the house is controlled by a heat pump system with each room controlled separately by a white wall mounted thermostat. The thermostat needs a direct "line of sight" to the AC wall unit, so you may need to close a door in the room for it to connect. The black Ecobee thermostats are for oil furnace heat only during colder months only.

HOUSE RULES

Welcome to the Porpoise Palace!



Beware of slippery steps and pathways if any ice, rain or snow. Keep doors closed and keep critters out.

No parties or events. No weddings. Maximum of 14 guests allowed. Occupancy is monitored.



No smoking, vaping or burning of candles allowed. \$500 fine. Warning: fire alarms sensitive and direct to Fire Dept.

No pets of any kind allowed. Not even in the garage. Some folks have allergies, including our kids. Strict \$500 fine.



Town wide quiet hours per ordinance start at 10pm, so no loud noise, music or outside disturbance. Neighbors will call police.

No consumption of alcohol or sedative substances while using hot tub or sauna. No glass. No jumping into hottub. Close the top on hot tub when not in use. See "Hot Tub Rules" sign posted next to hottub before use.



Enjoy a great bonfire, but flames should be no larger than 2 feet high. Use Maine firewood only, no trash or tree limbs. Firewood is sold locally at stores. Make sure fire is completely out when firepit not in use.

Children under 18 not to use any gym equipment. Risk of injury is assumed with use of any gym equipment.



Shoes off inside the house please. SHAKE OUT ALL SAND FROM TOWELS/GEAR OUTSIDE PLEASE. Sand damages our drains. Skis and beach gear can be stored on front side porch.

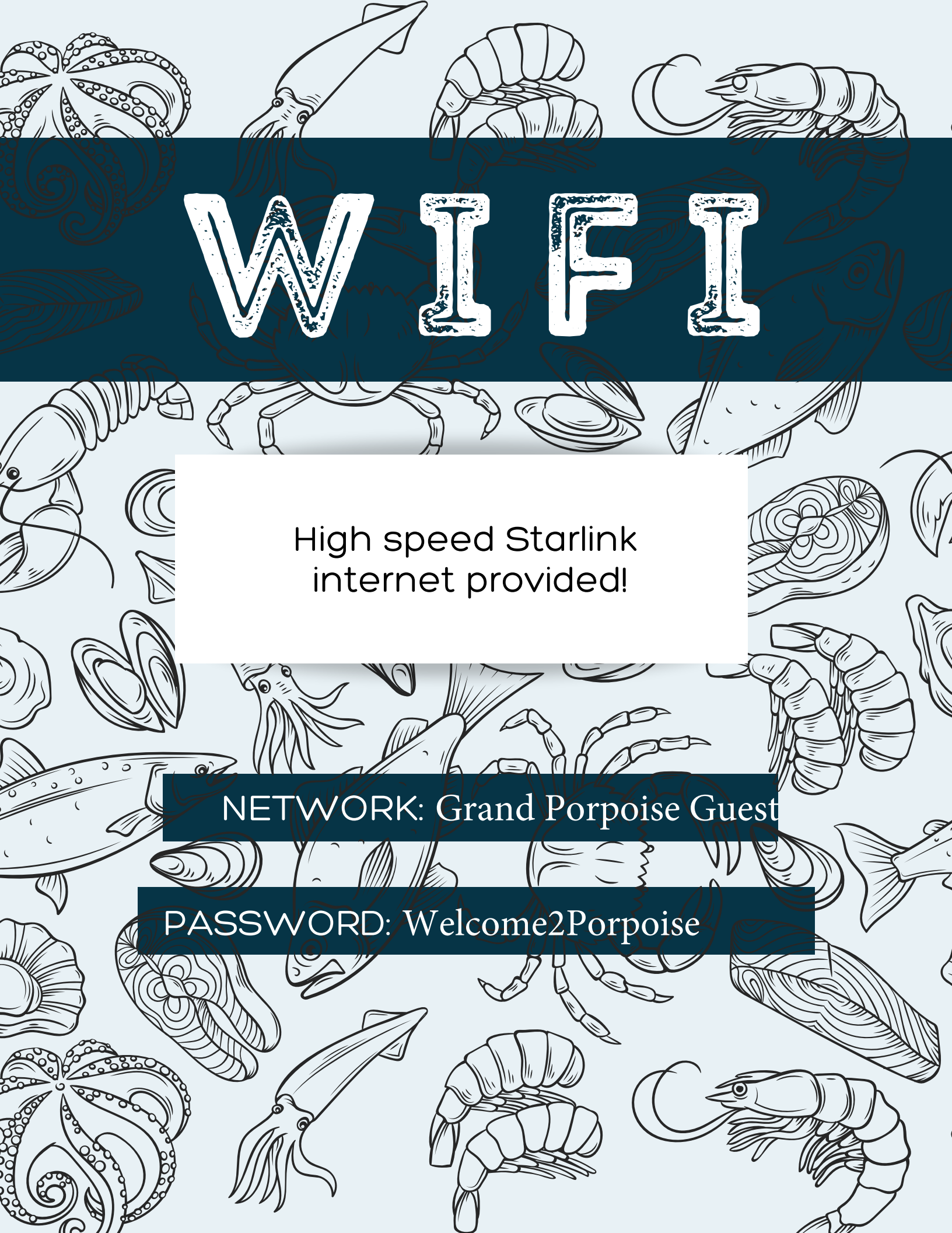

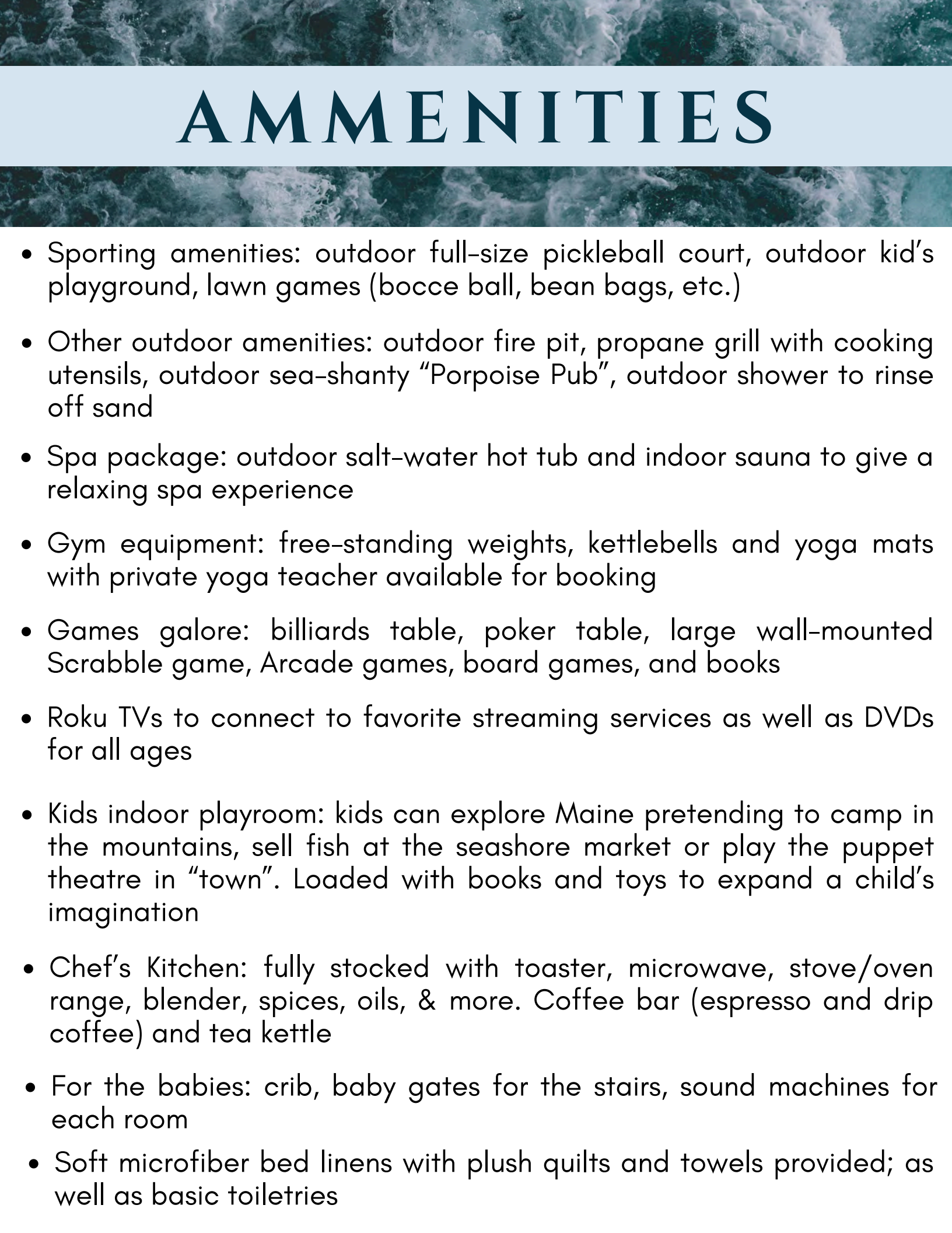

Grill, extra propane and grilling utensils are readily available. Please turn off after use and clean off after each use.



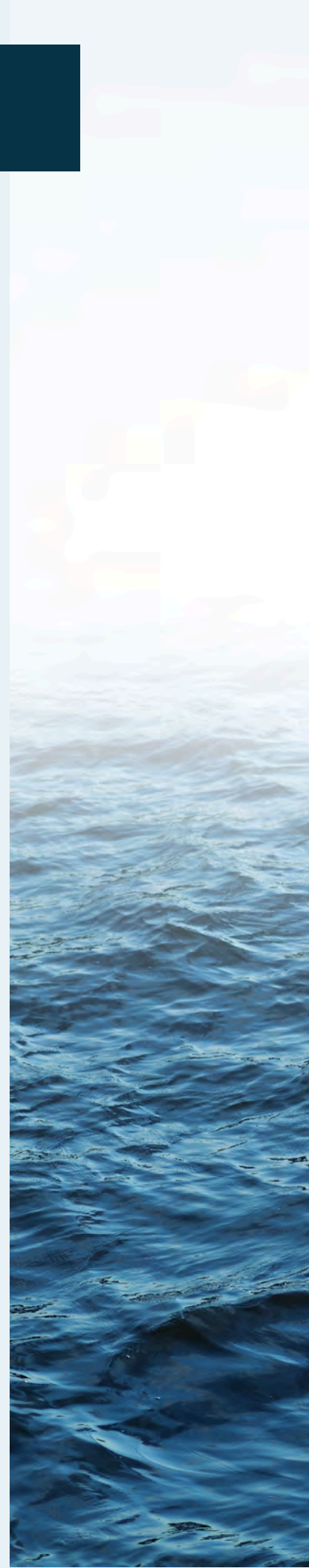
OUTDOOR PLAYGROUND

Please do not place hot items from oven directly on glass stove top as this can break the glass. Please make sure to turn off after every use.



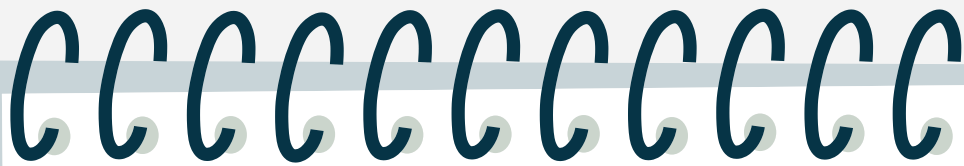
COFFEE BAR

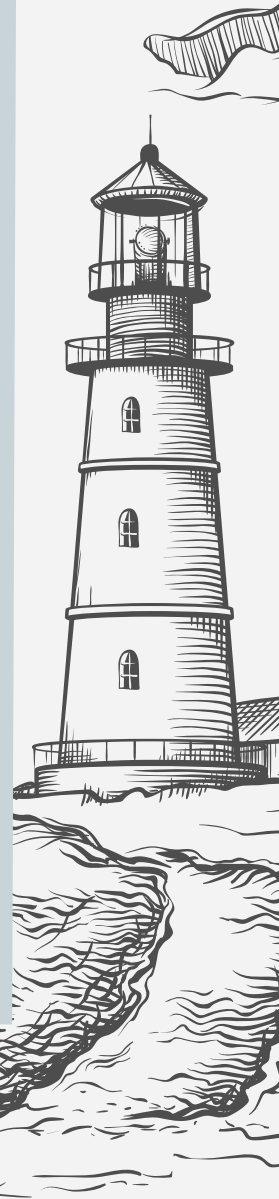

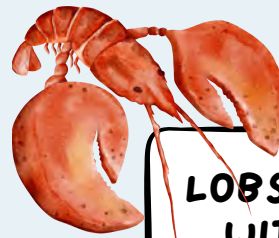

THINGS TO DO

- **Beaches**

- **Goose Rocks Beach** Our favorite gorgeous sandy beach 3 minutes away by car. Beach parking permits required and can be purchased at the Goose Rocks General Store or Kennebunkport Police Department). Wide white sand beach with tide pools and climbing rocks!
- **Colony Beach** Fantastic beach at the mouth of the river to watch boats come and go. Beware of currents. Limited parking. 8 min drive.
- **Kennebunk Beach aka Mother's Beach** Family friendly beach with tidal pools and a playground. No lifeguard on duty. No facilities. 10 min drive.
- **Gooch's Beach** Soft sand at low tide with waves for surfing. Parking Passport App or local sticker from Town Hall or the Chamber for parking. Connected to Mother's Beach by a boardwalk sidewalk. 10 min drive.
- **Ogunquit Beach** Phenomenal miles long stretch of peninsula between Ogunquit River and the Atlantic. Kids love roaming this wide vast beach. 25 min drive. Multiple sites for parking - we prefer Footbridge Beach Parking Lot.

 - At **Two Lights State Park (Cape Elizabeth)** grab fresh lobster rolls from **The Lobster Shack at Two Lights** with amazing views!
 - **Portland Head Light House (Cape Elizabeth)** is one of the most photographed lighthouses with a museum and a large park!
- **Scenic Outdoor Walks**
 - Take a coastal walk south from the rental on Mills Road and either go straight on **Langsford Road** or take a right on **Piers Road** for amazing views! To the end of the pier is 25 minutes!
 - **Rachel Carson National Wildlife Refuge** has 50 square miles of protected salt marshes for some epic bird watching! Nearby **Wells National Estuarine Research Reserve** also has some great hiking trails and bird-watching as well!
- **Farmer's Market**
 - Starting early May until November, check out the **Kennebunkport Farmer's Market** every Saturday from 8am- noon which features delectable goodies from Maine- fresh fruits/veggies, honey comb, cheeses, meats and pastries! - **Pick-Your-Own Fruits/Veggies**
 - Looking to do a traditional and delicious activity Maine is known for? **Dragonfly Meadow Blueberry Farm** is a local farm in Arundel with high bush blueberries that are naturally grown without pesticides! Call for picking season information at (207) 229 -0544.
 - **Spiller Farm** located in Wells is a great spot for fresh pick-your-own fruit and veggies starting with strawberries in June then raspberries, blueberries, veggies, pumpkins and apples into the fall! Check out their website www.spillerfarm.com

WINTER EDITION:

• Downhill Skiing

- You'll find multiple mountains close by – whether that be **King Pine Ski Area** (90 min drive with 17 trails geared towards beginners and intermediate skiers with snow tubing, ice skating, cross country trails and night skiing), **Gunstock Mountain** (90 min drive with 49 runs overlooking Lake Winnepesaukee on a larger mountain featuring night skiing, snow tubing and snow shoeing as well), **Pleasant Mountain Ski Area** (90 min drive to a classic Maine ski hill with 44 trails from beginner to advanced including night skiing), **Sunday River Resort** (110 min drive to Maine's largest and most popular ski areas with 130 trails across 8 mountain peaks) or **Black Mountain of Maine** (130 min drive with 50 trails over 1100ft vertical drop that is very well loved by locals and rarely overcrowded).

• Cross Country Skiing/Snowshoeing/Fat Biking

- **Harris Farm XC Ski Center** in Dayton is roughly 35 minute drive and offers one of the best Nordic ski centers with nearly 25 miles of groomed trails, a day lodge with a snack bar and rentals for xc skiing, snowshoeing and ice skating! They also feature fatbiking during the day as well! Details at www.harrisfarm.com/x-c-skiing.html.
- **Wells Reserve at Laudholm** is a great spot for guided tours for the beginners and the intermediate, featuring unique events such as a Full Moon Snowshoe Walk!

• Tubing

- Besides King Pine Ski Area and Gunstock Mountain, **Seacoast Adventure** in Windham Maine offers a 700 ft long snow tubing hill with music and LED lights as well as a carpet lift! More info at www.seacoastadventure.com.

• Ice Skating

- Get your ice skates on and head to the covered outdoor rink in the center of downtown Kennebunk at **Waterhouse Center Ice Rink!** Its free to use but skaters must bring their own skates.

• Dog Sledding

- Enjoy a unique winter activity with **Ultimate Dog Sledding Experience** in Hebron! A 90 minute drive away from a once-in-a-lifetime experience! Info at ultimatedogsleddingexperience.com.

- This two-week holiday celebration held in early December has given Kennebunkport/ Cape Porpoise the name the "Christmas Town" of America! The fun doesn't stop there with there being a hat parade, holiday themed trolley car rides, Christmas caroling at the Franciscan Monastery, Christmas markets, cookie crawls and Victorian Mansion Candlelight Tours of Christmases past!
