

Mini Itinerary For Early Arrival Into Palm Springs

Planning to arrive Palm Springs early in the day? You'll find plenty to do in and around town while the house is being prepared for your arrival. Below are some things to do on your first day in town.



Pick up maps at the Palm Springs Visitor Welcome Center

2901 N Palm Canyon Dr, Palm Springs, CA

Hop in the car and drive to the official visitor center for some flyers for discounts to local attractions. If you like mid-century modern, pick up "A Map of Modern Palm Springs." One item on the map is the visitor's center itself, which was originally a mid-century modern gas station.



Have brunch at Lulu California Bistro

Head South on Palm Canyon Dr to downtown. LuLu is a locally owned restaurant in the heart of downtown. The vibe here is quintessential Palm Springs! Request an outdoor table to dine alfresco. Enjoy a relaxing, casual meal and a libation while you people-watch in the warm weather. Use the time to look over the maps and flyers you picked up at the Visitor Center.



Grab a unique coffee beverage at Reserve★ by Starbucks

101 S Palm Canyon Dr, Palm Springs, CA

From LuLu, walk a full city block north and grab a unique coffee available only at this location. Head to the specialty bar and interact with a barista to craft you a custom beverage, such as clover brew, pour-over, cold brew, nitro cold brew, coffee press, chemex and siphon.



Stroll through a shaded palm tree grove at the new downtown park

230 N Museum Dr, Palm Springs, CA

Take your coffee and walk over to the city's all new 2-acre downtown park that features a dense palm grove, art, and an interactive grotto water feature (seasonal) for play and cooling. You'll also see folks taking pictures at the 30-foot-tall Forever Marilyn Monroe statue.



Go on a midcentury modern architecture self-driving tour

Various areas throughout Palm Springs, CA

Palm Springs is world famous for its perfectly preserved time-capsule of 1950s mid-century modern architecture. Using your "Map of Modern Palm Springs," head to sites that pique your interest. You'll also experience "Space Age" 1959 architecture at our vacation house, too!



Pick up groceries for your stay

Head to Albertsons, which is about a mile away from the house. This is a full-service supermarket with all departments, including a pharmacy, health and beauty products, wine & liquor, service deli, sundries, and an in-store Starbucks. Plan on 30-45 minutes for shopping!
