This restaurant is in walking distance and offers some of Houma's most unique and fresh dishes! Rachelle's favorite is the Bruschetta Chicken Panini and Lemon Brussel Sprouts. Brandon's is the Chicken Pesto Flatbread.

CRISTIANO RISTORANTE

This our favorite restaurant in town. The biggest mistake we made was letting our kids try the Chargrilled Oysters because they now eat them all. But they are amazing! Our favorites are the Bruschetta, Penne Al Forno, Chicken Parmesan, and Tortellini al Tartufo.



This Drew Brees' chain is a lot of fun and is filled with great food. Our favorites are the Ribeye Poboy, Chicken Berry Salad, Hickory Burger, Shrimp Tacos, and the Krispy Kreme Bread Pudding.



Big Mike's is our favorite local BBQ joint by far. The brisket, turkey, and sausage are our favorites. The Houma location is delicious but the Thibodaux location has live music many nights!

Here are some Cajun themed restaurants that are always fun and authentic.



You'll have a blast here especially on a Friday or Saturday night. You can feed the alligators and listen to live Cajun music. We love the fried chicken. Check their Facebook for their weekend lineup.



Any time we have friends from out of town, we take them to Boudreaux and Thibodeau's. We recommend the Lil' Bit o' Cajun so that you can try a little bit of everything South Louisiana offers - jambalaya, red beans and rice, grilled sausage and seafood gumbo. The classic cajun jokes imbedded on the tables are a super fun dinner conversation piece.



Abear's is a local lunch spot. The home-cooked food makes you feel like you are eating at Granny's house. The wait staff aren't as friendly as we'd like. However, for an authentic cajun stew, we don't mind. Sometimes, Granny has an off day.



Copeland's is a New Orleans staple. The creator of Popeyes really put his heart into the chain that carries his name. Our favorites are the spinach dip with fried pasta, crab cake pasta, steaks served on a sizzling platter, eggplant pirogue, and cheesecake.

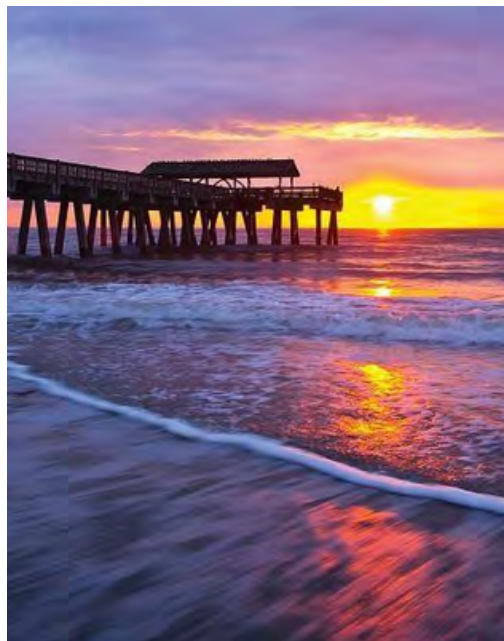
