- ✓ Buy Identical Sets Simplifies restocking, laundry, and pillowcase matching (no guessing games).

- → Queen = 4 pillows
- → Twin = 2 pillows
- + 2 Extra Pillows (minimum) stored in the closet

- ✓ Luggage Stand or Folding Rack Don't make them choose between suitcase and sanity.

## BATHROOM ESSENTIALS

A bathroom isn't just a place to rinse off — it's where guests decide if your space is actually clean, actually stocked, and actually worthy of 5 stars. From soft towels to forget something baskets, here's how to turn a basic bathroom into a guest-pleasing, turnover-friendly retreat.



✓ Bath Towels - At least 2 per guest, times 2.

two out, one in laundry, and backups for turnover and lastminute extras.

✓ Washcloths - 2 per guest out, times 2 for backup. Keep them soft, simple, and ready to rotate.

For Bath towels + Washcloths: Think: max guest count × 4 total.

✓ Cotton makeup cloths - Minimum (4) out per bathroom.

√Hand Towels - 2 per sink, then triple that.

One on the bar, One out as a replacement, one in the wash, one for the oops-we need replacements pile (Your cleaner will thank you).

✓ Toilet Paper - Guest visible + emergency stash. 3 rolls out minimum per bathroom + labeled backups. (Extra points if you don't make them text you for it).

✓ Toilet Paper Holder / Stand - Don't make them dig under the sink.

✓ Tissues - Place at least one box in every bathroom.

✓ Foaming Hand Soap Dispenser - Stylish and refillable.

Ditch the grocery store bottle with the label peeling off.

- ✓ Shower Dispensers Shampoo, Conditioner, Body Wash. Wall-mounted or refillable pumps = less waste, more chic. (Label them, please).
- ✓ refillable toiletries Shampoo, Conditioner, Body Wash. Buy large bottles of each for easy refill!
- ✓ Air Freshener Subtle, not scary. Go for clean linen or eucalyptus — skip the "Spring Burst."
- ✓ Small Trash Can (with liners!) Tuck one into every bathroom always with a liner for easy change-out.
- ✓ Child-Sized Bath Seat For toddlers or young guests who
  need extra support in the tub.
- ✓ Child Hair Rinse Cup Softer, curved edges = no shampoo meltdowns.
- ✓ Step Stool So little ones can reach the sink (and feel grown-up doing it).
- ✓ Toilet Plunger Hidden but accessible. Emergencies happen.
- ✓ Toilet Brush (with Discreet Covered Holder) No open-air brushes, please — choose one that hides neatly.

- ✓ Slip-Resistant Tub Mat or Non-Slip Stickers Safety first.

  Plus, they help protect your tub from scratches.
- ✓ Shower Mat (Outside Tub) Soft, fast-drying, and matches your vibe.
- ✓ Shower Caddy or Shelf Keep guest toiletries organized, not strewn across the floor.
- ✓ Shower Squeegee (for Glass Doors) Encourage guests to swipe down after showering saves on hard water stains and keeps your glass crystal clear.
- √Hair Dryer A basic model is just fine bonus points for including a diffuser or concentrator attachment for different hair types.

### Guest-Friendly Bathroom Signage:

- 1. Please, only toilet paper down the toilet!
- 2.Help keep our towels bright makeup remover cloths provideD!
- 3. Please turn on exhaust fan for a few minutes after each shower.

Small signs = fewer stains and happier turnovers.

- ✓ Throw Pillows (3-5) Keep it styled, not overstuffed. Use removable covers for easy washing.
- ✓ Smart TV or Streaming Device Login-ready with Netflix, Hulu, etc. Leave a welcome card with login tips (or guest account).
- ✓ TV Console or Cabinet Tuck away routers, cords, or board games.
- ✓ Charging Station or Extension Cords. USB-enabled power strips win you instant points.
- ✓ Coasters Trust us: a ring on your mid-century coffee table = not cute.

- ✓ Coffee Table + Side Tables Guests need somewhere to drop keys, mugs, and remote controls. Always.
- ✓ Full-Length Mirror (if not already in bedroom) Helps guests prep for weddings, events, or selfies or modern round mirror.
- ✓ Lamps + Overhead Lighting Warm bulbs preferred.
  Dimmer switches = extra luxe.
- ✓ Local Guidebook or Guest Binder Printed or QR-linked to TouchStay. Include WiFi info, house rules, and local picks.
- ✓ Books & Magazines for casual browsing.

✓ Kids' Toys Basket - Parents will thank you. We love Magna-Tiles, Duplos, quiet activity sets, and colored pencils and coloring books. (Stick to toys that are easy to clean and don't make noise when stepped on.).

## Kitchen Essentials

For guests who cook, caffeinate, and celebrate.

Your kitchen should feel fully stocked — not like a scavenger hunt with mismatched mugs and one sad butter knife. Here's what makes the difference between "it had what we needed" and "best Airbnb kitchen ever."



**The Must-Haves -** Equip your kitchen with the essentials every guest expects to find — whether they're flipping pancakes or heating up leftovers.

**Dinnerware + Silverware** (Diner Plates, Bowls, Salad Plates + forks, spoons, Knives) - Have enough for each guest to enjoy **3 full meals** without having to run the dishwasher between every snack.

If your max guest count is 4, you'll need:

- 4 guests × 3 meals = 12 of each item
- √ 12 dinner plates
- √ 12 salad plates
- ✓ 12 bowls
- ✓ Silverware 12 Forks, 12 Knives, 12 Spoons
- ✓ Cutting Knife Set (with Block or Magnetic Strip) Invest in a solid, sharp set — at minimum, a chef's knife, serrated knife, and paring knife.
- ✓ Basic Cookware Set (Nonstick) Frying pan, saucepan (at least 2 sizes), stockpot.
- ✓ Electric Skillet or Griddle A game-changer for breakfasts and group cooking compact and versatile.
- ✓Round Pizza Pan (12"+) At least one pan that fits a full-size pizza ideal for takeout nights or guest-made meals.

- √Casserole dish (glass or ceramic).
- ✓ Colander + Mixing Bowls Salad + pasta nights, covered.
- ✓ Cheese Cutter or Board Set For charcuterie night or that bottle of wine they definitely brought.
- ✓ Dish Drainer or Drying Mat Especially if there's no dishwasher or guests hand-wash specialty items.
- ✓ Dish Soap Dispenser (Refillable)
- Stylish > brand-name plastic bottle. Label it and keep it full.

#### **Cooking Utensils**

- √Spatula (heat-safe silicone or nylon)
- √Wooden or Silicone Stirring Spoon
- √Ladle (soups, stews, sauces trust us)
- √Whisk (for pancakes, eggs, and brownie batter emergencies)
- √Tongs (for grilling or salad tossing)
- √Can Opener (manual or electric, but please make sure it works)
- ✓Bottle Opener (for non-wine drinkers)
- √Peeler (for apples, potatoes, or fancy cocktails)
- $\checkmark$ Grater (cheese, garlic, citrus zest the holy trinity)

### Bar & Beverage essentials -

For guests who sip, shake, and unwind. A well-stocked bar setup turns evenings into memories.

- ✓ Wine Glasses (Red + White) One of each per guest (yes, both).
- . ✓ Non-shatter Wine Glasses for outdoor spaces (one for each guest).
- ✓ Whiskey or Rocks Glasses. At least 4 for your neatsipping guests.
- **√**Optional Margarita & or champagne glasses.
- √ High-End Wine Opener (Electric or Lever-Style) + 2-3
  backup corkscrews (because one will go missing)
- ✓ Beer Bottle Opener (Wall-mounted or handheld) Don't make them use the counter edge
- ✓ Cocktail Shaker + Strainer Bonus: jigger, muddler, or small bar set.
- ✓ Ice Cube Tray or Mold Especially if no ice maker is installed.

**Coffee Makers -** Because options = luxury — and backups = smart hosting. have a sign that shows the different options you provide.

- → Welter Pro TIP: We recommend offering more than one way
  to caffeinate. Not only do guests love the variety, but if a
  machine calls it quits mid-stay, you've got a built-in backup.
  (Trust us: no one leaves a 5-star review after a coffee
  crisis.)
  - Drip Coffee Machine
  - Kuerig or Pod machine
  - Espresso
  - Electric kettle
  - Pour Over
  - french press
  - ✓ Coffee Grinder (if not pre-ground)
  - ✓ Coffee Scoop + Storage Canister Label it. Keep it dry.

    Make it cute.
  - ✓ Ground Coffee + Extra Filters Even guests who don't drink pods still expect a solid pot of drip.

- ✓ Mugs (Lots and in All the Right Sizes)

  Have an assortment ready: larger mugs for cozy mornings, espresso cups for quick hits, and standard sizes for everything in between.
- → Welter Pro TIP: We love a mix of glass, ceramic, and colorful pieces and bonus points for branded or local mugs that add personality (and Instagram potential). 8-10 mugs minimum, even if your guest count is smaller. Mugs are the first thing to run out.

#### OTHER:

- ✓ Rubber Mat (Under Machines) Catches drips, protects your counter, and keeps things looking sharp.
- ✓ Coffee Bar Organizer Use a tray, drawer insert, or tiered shelf to keep pods, filters, stirrers, and extras tidy.
- ✓ Large Stock of Assorted K-Cups
  Include regular, flavored, decaf (a must), and a variety of roast levels.

✓Pods for Specialty Machines - Offer a variety of Nespresso or reusable pods for eco-conscious options.

✓ Tea Bag Variety Pack - Chamomile, Earl Grey, and green tea.

✓ Sweeteners & Creamers - Sugar, stevia, honey sticks, and
a mix of creamers — dairy and non-dairy.

✓ Descaling Solution or White Vinegar (for Machine Cleaning). Even the best coffee setup needs a little TLC. Keep a bottle of white vinegar or a dedicated descaling solution on hand for routine machine maintenance — especially for drip and pod systems.

#### **Bonus Touches:**

- Seasonal syrups (vanilla, pumpkin spice, peppermint)
- Cinnamon, honey sticks or cocoa powder
- Branded or local mugs
- Disposable to-go coffee cups with lids.

- ✓ Laundry Detergent Liquid, pods, or eco strips just make sure it's stocked and visible.
- ✓ Dryer Sheets or Wool Balls.
- ✓ Stain Remover Stick or Spray Great for families and long-term stays.
- ✓ Laundry Baskets (2-3) One for guests, one for cleaners, one for linen rotation.
- ✓ Drying Rack or Hanging Rod.
- ✓ Iron + Ironing Board (or handheld steamer) Tucked neatly in a closet or mounted inside the laundry room door.

- ✓ Table or Bistro Set Perfect for morning coffee or wine at sunset.
- ✓ Outdoor Lighting Solar path lights, string lights, or a simple motion sensor fixture.
- ✓ Grill (with utensils) Leave a grill brush, lighter, and clean grilling tools in a marked bin.
- ✓ Outdoor Rug or Welcome Mat- keeps dirt out of the house.
- √ Trash & Recycling Bins (Lidded + Labeled) Accessible and clearly marked.

✓ Doormat + Shoe Tray (Inside Entry) Encourages guests to leave the mess outside.

✓ Umbrella or Shade Solution - Especially helpful in summer or warmer climates.

### Firepit Essentials -

Because nothing says vacation like s'mores, stars, and a cozy fire.

✓ Adirondack Chairs (or Weatherproof Seating)

✓ Fire pit Table or Side Surface - Something sturdy for drinks, snacks, and s'mores kits.

√ S'mores Sticks (4-6) - Extendable metal skewers > foraged twigs.

✓ Firewood Rack (Stocked Neatly) - Dry logs, easy to access, covered if outdoors.

✓ Fire Poker + Fire Gloves - Safety tools = thoughtful host bonus point.

✓ Bug Spray - Keep the vibe going, not the mosquitoes.

### Safety & Supplies Essentials -

From emergency prep to quiet maintenance heroes, these are the behind-the-scenes items that protect your space and give guests (and cleaners) peace of mind.

- ✓ Fire Extinguisher Keep one in the kitchen and another near outdoor fire features. Make sure it's visible, labeled, and not expired.
- ✓ Fire Blanket (for stovetop emergencies)

  Compact, easy to use, and perfect for kitchens or BBQ areas.
- ✓ First Aid Kit (Clearly Labeled + Stocked)

  Band-aids, antiseptic, tweezers, gauze, gloves, allergy relief, and burn gel at minimum.
- ✓ Flashlights or Lanterns Include batteries and backup lighting for power outages bonus for red-light versions for outdoor use.

- ✓ Baking Soda + White Vinegar Natural, effective, and versatile for deodorizing or stain treatment.
- ✓ Magic Erasers (2-3) Scuffs on walls, marks on furniture, or mystery smudges — they handle it all.

- ✓ Disinfecting Spray or Wipes Make sure they're visible
  and not just buried under the sink
- ✓ Extra Trash Bags + Cleaning Cloths

  Keep them neatly stocked in a labeled bin or organizer under the sink or in the laundry room.
- ✓Lint roller a must-have for your cleaners.
- √Tide Pen for any pesky small stains.
- ✓ Carpet cleaner.
- ✓ Heavy Duty Sponges
- ★ Welter Pro Tip: Guests are more likely to tidy up when they know where to find what they need — label a small "Guest Cleaning" corner and stock it with care.
