- Conducted research on Parkinson's Disease alongside PhD students
- Studied the effect of the neuroinflammasome on neuroinflammation
- Independently cultivated cell lines, and performed experiments scanning for the presence of proteins such as IL-1 Beta to analyze the activity of the neuroinflammasome
- Dissected mice to obtain microglial cells from their brain mass
- Ran ELISA tests on BV2 cells to indicate levels of IL-1 Beta to set up controls between various levels of ATP and LPS to later run experiments with ACAT inhibitors used to test the effect of ACAT on cholesterol esters.
- Recorded biomarker data on BV-2 cells
- Created format to analyze different abstracts to predicted results through the use of artificial intelligence engines.
