PARKING DIRECTIONS

Tavi Haus operates seasonally, and Michigan's weather can be unpredictable, especially during the shoulder seasons. If you encounter unexpected snow or ice during your stay, we recommend parking at the top of the driveway and walking down cautiously. The driveway's incline has occasionally caused difficulties for vehicles, even SUVs, and towing services have been required in some cases. Your safety and comfort are our priority, so please take care when navigating the driveway.

TAP WATER

The house has well water so it is completely safe to drink, though minerals are present - if filtered tastes are preferred, we recommend using the fridge beverage center.



HEATING / COOLING


The thermostat is located in the kitchen on the main floor and controls the temperature for the entire house. If the basement feels chilly, the fireplace warms it quickly. A space heater is provided in the lower bedroom—please keep it in its designated spot to avoid tripping breakers.

We welcome use of the sauna and water sports equipment available at Tavi Haus! Upon arrival, please read and sign the waiver, take a picture, and send a photo to us to receive the access codes. Be sure to lock up after use!



BASEMENT

The lower level of the house is a big hit for watching movies, playing pool, or relaxing in the sauna. Please feel free to utilize these amenities!



WORK SPACE AREAS

There is a bright, airy workspace in the upstairs living room or an informal bar-top space in the basement. We provide options so you can be productive in the way that suits you best then take a break and experience Northern Michigan!



CHECK IN: AFTER 4PM

You'll receive your unique entrance code on the morning of your arrival. Since it's self-check-in, you're welcome to arrive any time after 4pm at your convenience (whether it's 4pm on the dot, 11pm, or 2am the next morning). We don't require a specific time or walk through with us!

CHECK OUT: BEFORE 10AM

We try to make your getaway as stress-free as possible... so we don't have a huge departure checklist. We simply ask that you start the dishwasher with the dishes you've used and leave the house in good condition. You are welcome to leave linens as they lie and leave trash bags in their respective cans around the home.

We've gotten feedback that some people want a little more guidance (we're both first-born children - we get it). If you'd like, you are welcome to take the trash out to the cans outside the garage (though not necessary) or pile your towels in the bathrooms (again, not required). We ask that you leave sheets on beds (you don't have to make them) so we can spot clean before washing.

TIPS FOR YOUR STAY

Be sure to sign/send the waiver on the dining table upon arrival so that you have full access to all the amenities!

We recommend starting the sauna about 30 minutes before you intend to use it so it can get up to temperature. There is an instruction guide posted in the basement near the sliding door.

TELEVISIONS

We have a drip machine and a french press so you can have one cup or an entire pot. We provide:

WASHER AND DRYER

These are located in the basement bathroom. You are welcome to use the detergent and dryer sheets provided. Be sure to empty the lint trap between loads.

DISHWASHER

Please start dishwasher with used dishes from your stay before you leave. There are pods available in the pantry to the right of the fridge.

To help us keep the space clean, please use the designated trash cans throughout the house. If needed, you are welcome to take trash bags out to the bins located at the top of the driveway. Please leave the bins at this location and do not bring them down to the house.



*BEACHES


- Empire Beach (South Bar, has a playground, bonfire pits)

- Black Star Farms






FISHTOWN (AKA LELAND)

This is the most adorable little fishing village. There are lots of little shops to wander through in between a tasty lunch and ice cream.

Things TO DO WITH KIDS

MOOMERS

The World-Famous Moomers is a fun place to get ice cream and admire the cow farm right outside. It's always a big hit for kids of all ages. The line may be long during the summer, but it moves pretty quickly so don't let that deter you!

HISTORIC BARNS PARK

Historic Barns Park and the Botanic Gardens are places we could spend an abundance of time. In this little area, there are masterful flower, butterfly, and Asian-inspired "secret" gardens, historic barns from the Old State Hospital, fairy gardens created by locals, trails into the woods that overlook the entire city, and a kid's garden with a couple fun activities. It's a great place for picnicking and exploring - and the best part is that it's completely free!

JACOB'S FARM

Jacob's Farm is a stunner for the summer and fall. With several play structures, lots of outdoor/flex seating, cocktails, cider, food, live music in the summer, corn mazes in the fall, it's a wonderful place that is fun for kids (and adults) of all ages!

GLEN LAKE SCHOOL PLAYGROUND

Glen Lake Schools built a state-of-the-art accessible playground that is a blast for kids of all ages. During the summer months (when school is not in session), this is a great place to get some energy out. It's very large and has many different types of structures to keep kids interested for hours.

SHADY LANE CELLARS


