OUR FAVORITE TRAILS

1. Slaughter Pen – Less than 10 feet from Great Adventure Stay's Bike In Bike Out Tiny Home, Slaughter Pen is Bentonville's original MTB destination boasting over 20 miles of trails.

Beginners enjoy the flowy All-American Trails while more advanced riders test their skills and play in the drops and jumps of The Boneyard.

2. Coler Preserve – Originally built as a showroom for RockSolid Trail Designers, with 17 miles of flow, x-country, rock, dual slalom and flyover trails. Coler has quickly become a favorite for locals and visitors alike.

Bring your money and stop and grab a coffee or a beer at The Hub within the preserve.

OUR FAVORITE TRAILS

3. Little Sugar – Hollers, ravines, waterfalls and more, the Little Sugar trails on the west side of Bella Vista are just steps away from Great Adventure Stay's Adventure Landing lake and bikehouse. This trail system is your all-weather biking destination. Get ready to climb and enjoy the rewards of spectacular downhills as well.

4. Back 40 Trails – visit the eastside of Bella Vista and explore the 21-mile outer loop of the Back 40. Park at the Lake Ann Trailhead or at our favorite, Blowing Springs. More experienced riders love to veer off and visit the black-diamond Ledges trail. Don't forget to stop and take pictures and be sure to bring an extra tube just in case.

EXPLORE NATURE

TANYARD CREEK NATURE PRESERVE AND WATERFALL

– Enjoy Bella Vista's most photographed waterfall and beautiful walking paths. To get to Tanyard Creek from Adventure Landing, turn right on Chelsea and follow it around to Lancashire. Turn right on Lancashire and find the parking lot 0.7 miles up on the right. From HWY 71, take HWY 340 (Town Center Exit) west. Watch for the Lake Windsor Dam on your left. Below the dam, turn left on Westford Lane and right into the parking lot. The trail leads off from the Pavilion to the right

THE BLUE HOLE (a local favorite swimming hole)–

When it gets hot, locals have been known to cool off in local swimming holes. The Blue Hole is a favorite of our family. You'll find perfectly shallow areas for young children and deep holes under the cliffs and ledges off which people love to jump. Park by Phat Tire Bike Shop, 3803 NW Wishing Springs Dr, Bentonville, and cross the grassy patch to the creek. Get ready to experience some local flavor!

LOCAL CULTURE

CRYSTAL BRIDGES MUSEUM OF AMERICAN ART

– (FREE ADMISSION) Created by Alice Walton and sponsored by The Walton Family Foundation, Crystal Bridges houses many American favorites including Warhol, Rockwell and more. Don't forget to explore the grounds as well. You can easily spend a few hours exploring and/or biking the mountain biking trails on the property too!

THE MOMENTARY – (FREE ADMISSION) A satellite to Crystal Bridges, The Momentary offers an ever-changing art exhibit. Get there after 5pm and find your way to the Tower Bar up on the rooftop for fabulous views and a fun social experience.

THE AMAZEUM – Rainy day or ready to take a break from the lake? Take the kids to The Amazeum, Bentonville's State of the Art Children's Museum, perfect for all ages. From The Hershey Chocolate Labs to 3M's Tinkering Lab to Outdoor Playscapes and more! You're sure to get your money's worth of fun!
